UPDATED GUIDANCE ON SINGING IN THE LITURGY The Ministry for Housing, Communities and Local Government has updated the Places of Worship Guidance on singing from 28th March. This is in line with the road map which the Prime Minister published in February and corresponds to the successful reaching of point 1b. The main changes are that small groups of singers will be allowed to perform, or rehearse for performance, only where essential to an act of communal worship. This should be limited to as few singers as possible, with social distancing being maintained at all times. Communal singing should not take place. As soon as we can get music back into masses we will but we are not quite there yet. We have been strictly following the government/Diocesan rules throughout the pandemic and will continue to do so until the end. Thank you for your understanding.
