CENTENERARY OF THE FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING

The Feast of Christ the King is celebrated in the Roman Catholic Church on the last Sunday of each liturgical year. It was established by Pope Pius XI in 1925 to respond to growing secularism and atheism. The feast honours Jesus Christ as Lord over all creation. It is a relatively new addition to the Church calendar and is designed to recognise the dominion Christ has over all aspects of our lives.

In this 'Holy Year of Hope', we are planning some liturgical and social celebrations of this significant date in the life of the Catholic Church and our parish.
