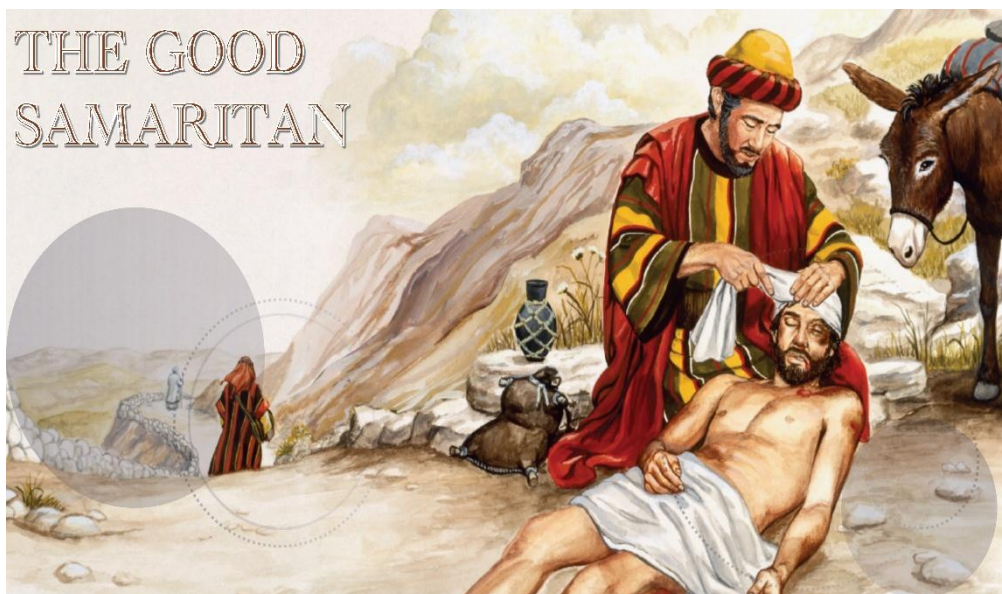


## FIFTEENTH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME
