**ONE PARISH FORUM & MASS TIMES:** Following last week's news concerning the amalgamation of Christ the King and St Mary of the Angels into one canonical parish, please note the following updates:

**One Parish Forum:** This will be formed from a small number of representatives of the two churches to assist the clergy in moving forward as smoothly as possible towards the reality of one parish family and one mission. When sufficient progress is made this forum will be extended to include representatives of all groups and ministries. This format we previously found worked well in combining two parishes.
