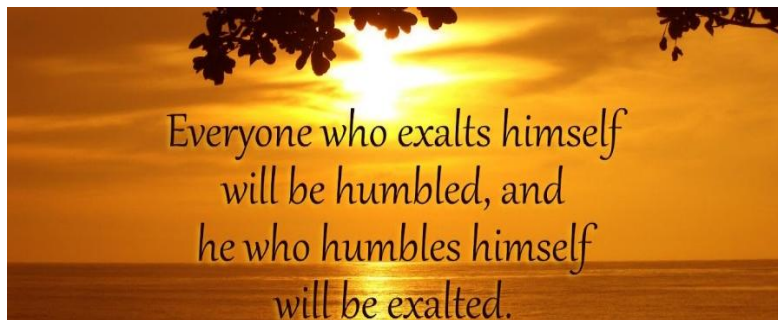


TWENTY SECOND SUNDAY YEAR C



PRAY FOR PEACE: St John Paul II wrote: "A number of historical circumstances also make a revival of the Rosary quite timely. First of all, the need to implore from God *the gift of peace*. The Rosary has many times been proposed by my predecessors and myself as a prayer for peace. At the start of the millennium which began with the terrifying attacks of 11th September 2001, a millennium which witnesses every day in numerous parts of the world fresh scenes of bloodshed and violence, to rediscover the Rosary means to immerse oneself in contemplation of the mystery of Christ who "is our peace", since he made "the two of us one, and broke the dividing wall of hostility" (Eph 2:14). Consequently, one cannot recite the Rosary without feeling caught up in a clear commitment to advancing peace, especially in the land of Jesus, still so sorely afflicted and so close to the heart of every Christian".

OUR NEW PARISH FAMILY & MASS TIMES: Next weekend we take on the parochial responsibility for the parish of St Saviour and St Mary of the Angels. The process of redefinition of the boundaries of St Saviour's and the amalgamation of Christ the King and St Mary of the Angels into one canonical parish, will then begin. As a path becomes clearer we will keep you informed but please note the following updates:

Parish Clergy Team as appointed by Bishop Mark will be:

Fr Louis Maggiore - Parish Priest

Fr Humphrey O'Connor - Assistant Priest / Deacon Tony Hunt - Parish Deacon

As requested by our bishop, we will look to work closely with and where appropriate, support the ministry of Fr Godlove & Deacon Tony Nuttall, the clergy in the parish of Our lady's & St Bernards, Ellesmere Port.

One Parish Forum: This will be formed from a small number of representatives of the two churches to assist the clergy in moving forward as smoothly as possible towards the reality of one parish family and one mission. When sufficient progress is made this forum will be extended to include representatives of all groups and ministries. This format we previously found worked well in combining two parishes.

Parish Mass Times: The Mass times to begin weekend of 6th / 7th September :

Saturday Vigil Mass at Christ the King 6pm. Sunday Masses 11am and 6pm.

Sunday Mass at St Mary of the Angels at 9am

ARRANGED BAPTISMS: Will be on Sundays **11am at SMOTA** or **1pm at CTK**

Baptisms can be arranged by meeting with the clergy after weekend Masses.

WEEKDAY MASSES: *For as long as we have two priests and a deacon, it is my intention, whenever possible, to provide a daily Mass and other liturgies at each of our two churches.*

PARISH SCHOOLS & YOUTH : *As always, working closely with our Catholic schools and our youth will be a priority as we seek to encourage young families to live their faith.*

Due to all parish commitments, it will be necessary to allocate much of the detail on a week-to-week basis. Where possible we will also seek to keep our churches open for daily prayer and visitation. We advise parishioners of the need to regularly check the newsletter for exact days/times of Masses and liturgies.

We very much look forward to the mission and ministry ahead, there is much work to be done, and the clergy team ask for your prayers and support. **Fr Louis**
