The process of redefinition of the boundaries of St Saviour's and the amalgamation of Christ the King and St Mary of the Angels into one canonical parish, can now begin. As requested by our bishop, we will look to work closely with and where appropriate, support the ministry of Fr Godlove and Deacon Tony Nuttall, the clergy in the parish of Our lady's & St Bernards, Ellesmere Port. They will always be welcome here in our parish and we also keep them and their ministry in our prayers.

<u>Parish Mass Times:</u> The Mass times to begin weekend of 6th / 7th September: Saturday Vigil Mass at Christ the King 6pm. Sunday Masses 11am and 6pm. Sunday Mass at St Mary of the Angels at 9am

ARRANGED BAPTISMS: Will be on Sundays 11am at SMOTA or 1pm at CTK

Baptisms can be arranged by meeting with the clergy after weekend Masses.

<u>WEEKDAY MASSES:</u> For as long as we have two priests and a deacon, it is my intention, whenever possible, to provide a daily Mass and other liturgies at each of our two churches.

One Parish Forum: This will be formed from a small number of representatives of the two churches to assist the clergy in moving forward as smoothly as possible towards the reality of one parish family and one mission. When sufficient progress is made this forum will be extended to include representatives of all groups and ministries.

<u>PARISH SCHOOLS & YOUTH</u>: Working closely with our Catholic schools and our youth will be a priority as we seek to encourage young families to live their faith.

Where possible we will also seek to keep our churches open for daily prayer and visitation. We advise parishioners of the need to regularly check the newsletter for exact days/times of Masses and liturgies.

We very much look forward to the mission and ministry ahead, there is much work to be done, and the clergy team ask for your prayers and support. *Fr Louis*
