



INSTRUCTION ON THE ROMAN CATHOLIC FAITH
PROPER RECEPTION OF THE MOST HOLY EUCHARIST

The heart of Catholic life is the Most Holy Eucharist, the source and summit of our faith (cf. *Lumen Gentium*, 11).

To receive Holy Communion is, therefore, to encounter the living God. It is a sacred act that unites the communicant not only with Christ, but with the Church and all her teachings. But this divine encounter requires proper preparation. One must first be in a state of grace, free from mortal sin. In modern society a present risk is to receive the Holy Eucharist whilst living in a partnership/union that is outside of sacramental marriage. (Marriage in the Catholic Church) The Catechism of the Catholic Church is clear: “Anyone who desires to receive Christ in Eucharistic communion must be in the state of grace” Thus, regular confession is not simply for grave offenses—it is the ordinary means by which God prepares the soul for extraordinary grace. (Catechism of the Catholic Church 1415; cf. 1 Cor 11:27-29).

SAFEGUARDING: We must ensure that all who need an enhanced DBS have one. If you completed one in the past but are not sure if it is still valid, then please contact Alex in the Parish Office or Clare Connor at clareconnor_dc@yahoo.co.uk. If you are unable to get to the office to complete your DBS, we will be holding a drop-in session at Christ the King following 11am mass on **Sunday 1st March**. Claire will verify identity documents and Alex can photocopy them ready to send to the Curial office for processing. If you can complete these forms before then and we can get them verified, then please don't wait for the drop in. Following recent guideline changes, **all volunteers** within the Diocese of Shrewsbury that don't need a DBS now need to complete a Volunteer Registration Form. Alex will be speaking to different groups about filling in these forms and will help you if required.

SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION AT CHRIST THE KING & ST MARY OF THE ANGELS

Bishop Mark will visit the parish on the evening of July 1st for a Confirmation Mass at Christ the King church.
